# letter from our lead pastors

LEAD PASTORS

The theme for 2025 was RISE, and God has truly caused Christian Life Center to rise in every area of ministry this year! From salvations to missions, from discipleship to outreach, we have seen the hand of God at work.

Everything we do is to bring souls into the Kingdom of God, and this year we celebrate 462 decisions for Christ, with 309 baptized in water! These are not just numbers – they represent lives forever changed by the power of the Gospel.

**SPIRITUAL GROWTH & BIBLE ENGAGEMENT**  
A major focus this year has been Bible Engagement. Together as a church family, we read through 10 books of the Bible, drawing closer to God through His Word. Our daily Rise & Pray gatherings have grown to nearly 300 participants every morning, passionately pursuing the presence of God together.

Through the TAP Method – Truth, Application, Prayer – our church continues to deepen spiritual roots, developing habits of daily devotion and prayer.

### CHURCH GROWTH & ATTENDANCE

This year, attendance has continued to climb, reaching an average of 2,735 across all campuses. Our Easter Weekend saw an incredible 6,313 people attending in-person services



to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ! We thank God for the growth and for every life that has been reached through each campus and our online platform.

### KINGDOM BUILDERS & GLOBAL MISSIONS

This year, CLC gave a record-breaking \$870,616 through Kingdom Builders! Through your generosity, we supported missionaries, built churches, trained leaders, and funded global outreach in alignment with our mission to Reach, Teach, Plant, and Care for the lost around the world.


